

Wrangell Community Garden Site Instructions

Welcome to the Wrangell Community Garden (WRC)! We are glad to have you as part of our community and hope to see you out at the site often. Below are some general instructions regarding our site so you can help us keep it clean, safe and accessible for others to enjoy as well.

Keys
Garden bed renters can obtain a key to the garden shed. Only one (1) key will be administered per garden bed renter. If at any time during the gardening season the board members feel a garden bed renter has not adhered to the rules and regulations, the key may be revoked. If a garden bed renter does not wish to renew their garden bed at the end of the growing season, they shall return their key to one of the board members.

Shed
Please be considerate of your neighbors by keeping a clear walkway and a tidy workspace in the shed. Shelves are provided for storing personal garden tools/needs and also for community items that are free for the taking. The Wrangell Community Garden is not responsible for lost and/or stolen items left in the shed. Please write your name legibly on any items you may wish to leave in the shed. Announcements may be posted on the outside bulletin board on the west side of the building. Please remember to lock the shed after you are finished using it.

Equipment/Tools
You may use WRC's equipment and tools, which are kept in the closet and marked with orange spray paint. Please do not take these items off the garden site for personal use. Please spray down and return all the equipment/tools to the shed after you have finished using them. If any of the tools need maintenance, please contact the Site Manager. Nails, wood, and wire stored in the dugout will also be labeled if it available for anyone to take.

Hoses
Two hoses are connected to the faucets on the east side of the shed. One hose is left on the east side of the shed to spray down items and the other runs out to the garden through the chain link fence. Please do not disconnect the hoses from the faucets or put the hoses in the shed. After using the hoses, please coil the hoses in their respective spots and turn off the faucets. Please do not take the hoses off the garden site for personal use. If the hoses need maintenance, please contact the Site Manager.

Gates/Entry
As in the rules and regulations, the Wrangell Community Garden does not allow dogs. Please close the gates behind you in order to prevent dogs from wandering into the garden. If necessary, the service gate entrance may be used to deliver large items to garden beds or compost bins, again closing it behind you once you have finished delivering your goods.

Compost
Compost may be dropped off at the bins on the northeast side of the garden. Please pay attention to posted guidelines and announcements.

Volunteering
Like with composting, the more you put into the garden, the more you get out of the garden. If you see something that needs doing, feel free to dig in!
